On April 7, University City voters will be asked to approve a \$53.6 million zero-tax-rate increase bond measure known as Proposition U to finance the construction of two new schools – Barbara Jordan and Pershing Elementary Schools, and pay for renovations at the district's existing elementary schools, middle school and high school. The ballot request is part of the district's overall plans, based on Destination U.City Schools' recommendations, that are aimed at reforming not only its aging facilities but its academic offerings as well.
